Financial Commitment

Upon application, there is a one-time \$100 non-refundable application fee and an initial installment of \$100 toward your Rotary International Foundation contribution. Membership dues (which include meals) are \$335 per quarter and shall be paid within 30 days from the due date. On average, each new member should anticipate spending approximately \$2,000 annually for Rotary related activities, dues, and lunches.

Attendance

Each new member is requested to attend and participate in all weekly Rotary luncheons because that's how we get to know each other. It's expected that you will attend at least 65% of the meetings and notify our Club Administrator if you will be absent. Our Rotary club maintains membership attendance records and we have to guarantee the hotel a minimum number for weekly lunches. Guests are always welcome at \$30.00 per person.

Participation

Rotary is a service organization, whose motto is "Service Above Self." Each new Rotary member is expected to participate in our club activities and to become more familiar with our Rotary club, our Rotary charity projects, fellow Rotarians, and Rotary International. The more a member becomes involved with Rotary, the more Rotary, our community and the world will benefit. You will be a representative of your profession and Rotary in our community.

Solicitation & Ethics

You'll frequently hear anecdotes at club meetings about "Rotarians helping Rotarians" to resolve business needs and issues. The use of our membership directory for direct mailings and email that is NOT solicited, however, is strictly prohibited, as is the use of membership data to market for non-Rotary events. If you would like to highlight a charitable event during a weekly meeting that is not related to Rotary, please seek permission from the Club President first. Please do NOT ask the Club Administrator to send out an email to the general membership soliciting sponsorship, ticket sales or volunteers. Any commitment from the Club requires Board approval.

Establishing business relationships with fellow Rotarians is strongly encouraged as Rotary was founded on the principle of promoting ethics in business. Therefore we expect you to conduct yourself to the highest ethical standards in your personal and business lives.

Four Way Test

Rotary International has set up particular guidelines as to the way each member should conduct themselves. We expect each Rotarian to live and work by these principals. The Four-Way Test is the cornerstone by which all Rotarians should, think, say or do:

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR to ALL Concerned?
